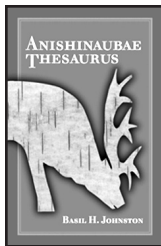

Intended as a supplement to Bibliography of Publications on Old English Literature (Toronto), which omits dissertations, Pulsiano's work provides coverage through the year 1986.

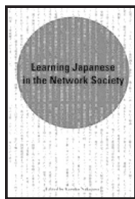

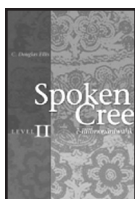
