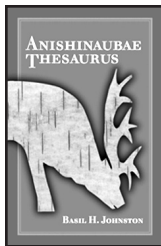

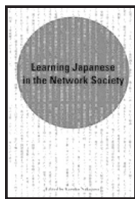


Anishinaubae Thesaurus

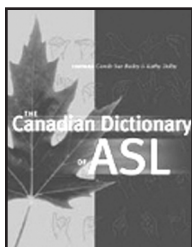

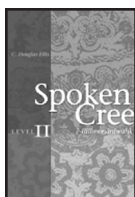
