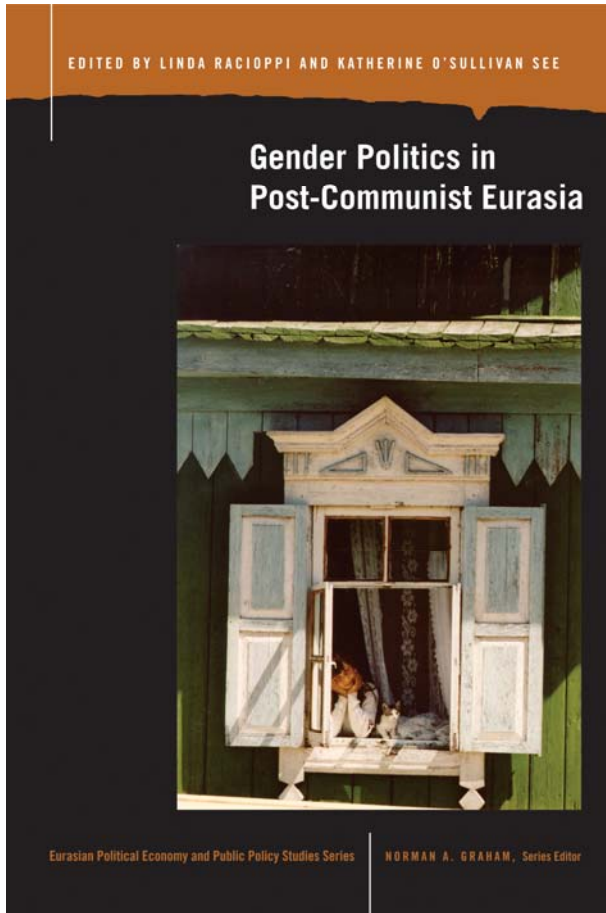


# Gender Politics in Post-Communist Eurasia
